Bluegrass and BBQ was brought up and Leland stated that there are seven bands signed up and a couple of food vendors. They would like to see this event moved to the square, as well.

Motion to adjourn by Councilman Allen and seconded by Councilman Workman. Unanimous vote to adjourn.


Mayor Doubek adjourned the regular session meeting at 12:57 p.m.


