PURPOSE:

To propose instituting a new speed limit.

BACKGROUND:

After reviewing a report of the Neosho Traffic Commission, it has been determined that the appropriate speed limit for Howard Bush Drive between Highway D and Nelson Avenue is 35 miles per hour.

RECOMMENDATION:

City Staff recommends that City Council approve the proposed new speed limit.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, DESIGNATING A “SPEED LIMIT OF 35 MILES PER HOUR” ON HOWARD BUSH DRIVE FROM HIGHWAY D NORTH TO NELSON AVENUE AND FROM NELSON AVENUE SOUTH TO HIGHWAY D, AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THERE OF.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Neosho has determined after reviewing a report of the Neosho Traffic Commission that the appropriate speed limit for Howard Bush Drive between Highway D and Nelson Avenue is 35 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Neosho is desirous of instituting this speed limit change expeditiously.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: No person shall operate a motor vehicle in the City of Neosho at a speed in excess of 35 miles per hour within the following street/road/highway location:

On Howard Bush Drive from Highway D North to Nelson Avenue and from Nelson Avenue South to Highway D.

Section 2: That any other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, be and hereby are, repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of passage.
