The Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG) Program is awarded to the State of Missouri by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, and Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA). The Missouri Department of Public Safety is the state administering agency of these federal funds.

The LLEBG Program allows for awards up to \$9,999.99 for the purchase of basic law enforcement equipment, with a priority for items that increase officer safety. Past years of funding have allowed for patrol vehicles (sedans and SUVs), light bars, sirens, vehicle partitions, ballistic vests, radios/repeaters, in-car cameras, body cameras, mobile data terminals, flashlights, handcuffs, leg irons, trauma kits, and jail surveillance systems.

There is no local match requirement on the 2019 LLEBG program.

The 2019 LLEBG Funding Opportunity will open as scheduled on Monday, August 6, 2018. The 2019 LLEBG Solicitation will be posted online at <https://www.dps.mo.gov/dir/programs/cjle/llebg.php>.

Applications will be due no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 4, 2018. Applications must be submitted via the Missouri Department of Public Safety's WebGrants system at <https://dpsgrants.dps.mo.gov>.
